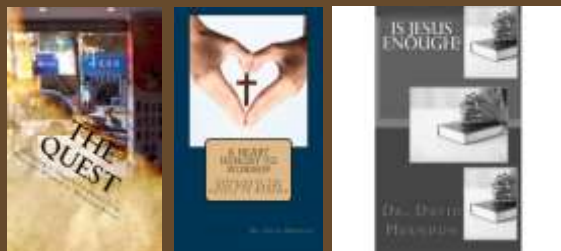

Projects being worked on
